Children will learn to identify and name everyday materials and will have the opportunity to explore the properties of these materials.

At the end of the unit children apply their knowledge of everyday materials to sort objects by their properties.

In our art topic, the children will be exploring pattern and texture through a range of creative activities. They will learn how artists use repeating shapes, lines and surfaces to create interest, and will experiment with different materials to create their own textured and patterned artwork.
