I am writing to confirm that Croxton Kerrial Church of England Primary School continues to take part in a project that is run jointly between schools and Leicestershire Police.

Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced, any domestic abuse.

Operation Encompass will ensure that a member of the school staff, the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) also known as a Key Adult, is trained to liaise with the police and to use the information that has been shared, in confidence, while ensuring that the school is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families, who have been experienced a domestic abuse incident.
