Shanghai

Shanghai is a mega-city located on the east coast of China. Shanghai has not always been the largest container port in the world. It grew because people made the decision to invest in building around the city. People move to Shanghai for work. There is a lot of work in Shanghai but little work in some remote villages around Shanghai. Many people have left villages to live and work in the city.

Brancaster is a small fishing village located in Norfolk on the east coast of the UK. The land is fertile and the climate is fertile. Most of the land is given over to farming so there is no need to worry about additional land to grow enough food. 200 years ago, Brancaster was a busy cargo port. As shipping technology developed, ships became larger and needed larger ports to dock in. Brancaster did not develop to accommodate larger ships.
