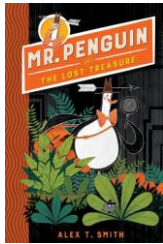

## Geography

### Rivers

In this unit we explore the links between landscape, economy and the environment. Pupils learn the location of major rivers in the UK and worldwide. They learn the journey of a river from source to mouth and identify how rivers change the physical features of the landscape.

### Art

### Light

Pupils focus on both the development of light and tone, while being introduced to Mosaic artists who use a different form. Key learning from this unit of work includes knowledge of the artistic styles of Caravaggio, Vermeer, Rembrandt, and Antoni Gaudi.
