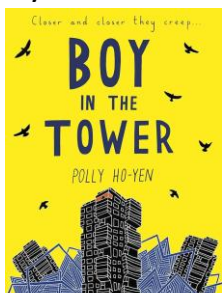

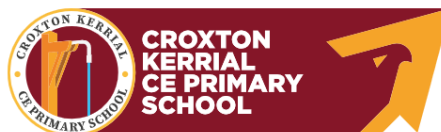

### Classification

Pupils will learn about how scientists classify and categorise living things. They will look at the work of Linnaeus who developed modern taxonomy.

They will learn about the different classes and families of animals and plants
